How to Zoom In and Out in Google Chrome

Zoom In or Out on Your Current Page

Use the zoom options to make everything on a web page larger or smaller.

1. On your computer, open Chrome.
2. At the top right, select **More** ⋮.
3. Next to **Zoom**, choose the zoom options you want:
 - Make everything larger: **Zoom in** +.
 - Make everything smaller: **Zoom out** −.
 - Use full-screen mode: **Full screen** ⛶.

You can also use the keyboard shortcuts to zoom in or out:

4. Make everything larger:

- Windows and Linux: **Ctrl and +**.
- Mac: **⌘ and +**.
- Chrome OS: **Ctrl and +**.

5. Make everything smaller:

- Windows and Linux: **Ctrl and -**.
- Mac: **⌘ and -**.
- Chrome OS: **Ctrl and -**.

6. Use full-screen mode:

- Windows and Linux: **F11**.
- Mac: **⌘ + Ctrl + f**.
- Chrome OS: At the top of your keyboard, press the full screen key . This key is also called **F4**.

Set Page or Font Size for All Web Pages

You can change the size of everything on the web pages you visit, including text, images, and videos, or you can change just the size of the font.

Tip: Some websites don't let browsers change only the text size. For those sites, Chrome won't be able to adjust the font size.

1. On your computer, open Chrome.
2. At the top right, select **More**  **Settings**.
3. Under **Appearance**, make the changes you want:
 - Change everything: Next to **Page zoom**, click the **Down arrow** . Then select the zoom option you want.
 - Change font size: Next to **Font size**, click the **Down arrow** . Then select the font size you want. You can also change more font options by choosing **Customize fonts**.
