# Phone Calls

When you're new to your iPhone, making a phone call can be a little tricky at first. But a couple of simple tips and tricks can make placing and receiving phone calls so much easier. **Try it out!**

## Making a Call

1. Open the **Phone** app.
2. Using the number keypad, type in the number you want to call.
3. Double-check you entered the right number by touching the phone number; VoiceOver will read it back to you.

**Tip: To fix a mistake, find the delete button below the pound button in the number keypad.**

4. Touch the **Call** button, then double-tap to place the call.

5. When you're done, the **Call** button has turned into an **End** button. Touch the **End** button and double-tap to end the call.

**Tip:** The easiest way to end a call is to use the two-finger double-tap gesture. You won't have to hunt for the **End** call button.

## Answering a Call

6. When the phone rings, two-finger double-tap to answer the call.

**Tip:** Use the two-finger double-tap for both ending and answering a call.
