Music Library Basics

Did you know that the music library is where all your music is stored?

The music library on your device stores all the music you've purchased from iTunes and any music that you've synced to your device from your computer. VoiceOver helps you navigate through the library. **Try it out!**

Exploring the Library Screen

1. Open the **Music** app. The focus is on the **Library** heading.
2. Right swipe through the five options. VoiceOver announces each one:
 - **Playlist:** Displays all the playlists you've created.
 - **Artists:** Organizes your music alphabetically by artist.
 - **Albums:** Organizes your music alphabetically by album name.

- **Songs:** Organizes your music alphabetically by song title.
- **Downloaded Music:** Displays a list of all the music currently downloaded to your device.

Tip: If you don't have a Wi-Fi connection, and don't want to use up cellular data, choose from **Downloaded Music** to ensure that you are only playing music you've downloaded to your device and not streaming from iCloud.

3. Continue to right-swipe past **Downloaded Music**, which ends the **Library** list, to reach **Recently Added**. Here you can right-swipe through all the songs or albums you recently added to your music library.

Moving Through the Artists List

4. Left swipe until you return to the **Artists** list.
5. Double tap to open the list. The focus is on the **A-to-Z section index** on the right side of the screen. Artists are listed alphabetically by first name.
6. There are two ways to check out all the artists in your list:
 - **Right swipe** to move through the list.

- Use the **Section Index**. Swipe up to move backward through the index. Swipe down to move forward.

Tip: Each time you swipe, VoiceOver tells you what letter section you are in. Stopping on a letter filters your list to show only the artists whose names begin with that letter.

7. Stop on a letter that has a few artists. Right swipe to move through the list of artists in that section.
8. To quickly move to a new letter, touch the section index along the right side of your screen. Then swipe up or down until you reach the letter you want.
9. Again, right swipe through the artists in that section.
10. Stop when you reach an artist with multiple albums in your library.
11. Double tap to open the album list for that artist. The focus is on **Play**.
12. If there is more than one album, right swipe to reach the one you want. You can then double tap to see a list of all the songs on that album.

13. Right swipe to the song you want to hear, and double tap to start playing.
