Adjusting the Text Size

Wouldn't it be great to be able to change the text size on your iPhone or iPad?

Apple gives you the ability to enlarge the text size across all your Apple apps. **Try it out!**

Tip: The following instructions are for the iPad. However, they are very similar whether you're using an iPad, iPhone, or even an iPod Touch.

Adjusting Text Size

1. Tap the **Settings** app on your device **Home** screen.
2. Tap **Accessibility** in the **Settings** list to see your accessibility options list.
3. **Display and Text Size** is the third item in the list. Tap to open its settings.
4. Tap **Larger Text**, the second item in the list, to open its settings.

5. Turn on **Larger Accessibility Sizes** by tapping the toggle button.
6. Next, touch and drag the slider bar to the right to enlarge the text.
7. If the text is too large, drag the slider to the left to make it smaller.
8. When the text is a size you like, lift your finger from the slider.
9. Now, all your apps will use the text size you just set.
