



iPhone/iPad for Low Vision

Typing Feedback

If the tiny letters on your onscreen keyboard are hard to see, your iPhone or iPad has something that can help!

Typing Feedback is a feature that reads characters and words aloud as you type. This helps you know for sure that you've typed exactly what you meant to. **Try it out!**

Tip: The following instructions are for the iPad. However, they are very similar whether you're using an iPad, iPhone, or even an iPod Touch.

Typing Feedback Options

1. Open the **Settings** app on your **Home** screen.
2. In the **Settings** list, tap **Accessibility**.
3. Then tap **Spoken Content** in the **Accessibility** settings list.
4. Next, tap **Typing Feedback** to open its options.

Tip: This workshop focuses on the Characters and Speak Words settings. Be sure to come back and explore the other settings to see which ones work best for you.

Characters and Speak Words Settings

5. Tap the **On/Off** toggle button to turn on **Characters** so that each time you type a character you hear it spoken aloud.
6. Then tap the **On/Off** toggle button next to **Speak Words** so that your typed words are spoken aloud as well.
7. Close the **Settings** app.

Using Typing Feedback

8. Open the **Notes** app on your **Home** screen.
9. In a new note, type the sentence, “This is super fantastic” without the period at the end.

As you type, the characters will be spoken aloud. And once you tap the spacebar, the words will be spoken aloud.

10. Tap the space bar twice quickly to automatically add the period. This shortcut saves you from hunting for the tiny period!
