Use Appendix 1 of *The Rules of UEB* to determine usage in longer words.

Use *blind*, *first*, *friend*, *good*, *letter*, *little*, and *quick* in longer words that are not in Appendix 1 as long as the shortform is at the beginning of the word and is not followed by a vowel or a *y*.

Use *children* anywhere in longer words, except if followed by a vowel or *y*.

Do not use shortforms next to a forward slash.
