

Line Continuation Indicator

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Used to divide unspaced information too long to fit on one line.

Make the division at a logical break—usually before or after punctuation. Do not make a break between letters within a word or digits within a number.

Examples:

- a long web address or electronic address

- numbers that are too long to fit on one line
(do not repeat the numeric indicator)
5,000,000,000,000,000,000,000,000,000

- any symbols-sequence too long for one line
He spoke so quickly that it sounded like all one word when he said,
“Whycan’tlgotothepartywithmyfriendtomorrow?”
