



Android Low Vision Features

Wallpaper and Styles

Your device's default wallpaper or background may have a busy pattern, making it difficult to see the apps and items on your screen. Follow these steps to change the wallpaper on your device running the latest version of Android.

Changing Your Device's Wallpaper

1. Tap on the **Settings** app to open it.
2. Scroll down to **Wallpaper & Style** and tap to open it.
3. Select **Change Wallpaper**.
4. Select **Solid Color** and choose a wallpaper color.

Tip: Choosing solid color wallpaper, especially a dark color, like black, provides good contrast and makes it easier to see what's on your screen than if you use the default patterned Android wallpaper.

5. Tap the **check mark icon** at the bottom right side of the screen to apply the change.
6. Choose **Home Screen, Lock Screen, or Home and Lock Screens** to set both.

Tip: You can choose distinct colors for the Home and Lock screens to make items on the screen easier to see. Or choose Home and Lock Screens to set the same solid contrasting color for both.
