

Makeup Tips and Tricks:

Lip Liner and Lipstick

- Tighten your lips by slightly curling them inward toward your teeth. This makes applying lip liner easier.
- Consider other options for applying lip color: using a lipstick tube, a sponge tip applicator, or your finger directly onto the lip itself.
- You may find thin lipstick tubes easier to control than thicker ones.
- If you purchase makeup and sponge tip applicators are included, don't throw them away! Sponge tip applicators are another option for applying lipstick. They can also be purchased from your local department store.
- Eyeliner and lip liner pencils can be hard to tell apart—they are both so thin. Wrap a piece of duct tape around your eyeliner pencil, and wrap masking tape around the lip liner. Or mark one of them with a rubber band, a brightly colored sticker, or a mark you can feel.
