iPhone/iPad VoiceOver: Save Favorite Sites

Apple's Safari browser with VoiceOver makes it easy to save your favorite websites.

Safari is Apple's built-in web browser, and with VoiceOver you can use it to save, or bookmark, your favorite sites so you can get to them more quickly. **Try it out!**

Opening the Safari Browser

1. Tap the **Safari** icon, usually found in the dock at the bottom of your device screen.

Tip: If you've recently used Safari, it will open on the last web page you visited.

2. If **Safari** opened on a web page, skip to step 4. Otherwise, tap the **address bar**.

3. Double tap the **address bar** and enter a search term or web address that you'd like to save.
4. Once your web page opens, touch the **Share** button at the bottom center of your device screen. Then double tap to open the **Share** options.
5. Right swipe to the **Add Bookmark** button and double tap it.

Adding a Bookmark

6. The focus is on the **Page Name** edit field which contains the name **Safari** gave the website.
7. Right swipe to the **Clear Text** button. If you want to change the name of your saved page, double tap and type in a new name.
8. Right swipe until you hear the web address of your website. Do not change this information or your bookmark won't work.
9. Right swipe to the **Location** heading.
10. Right swipe again to open the folder list.

Tip: Bookmark is the default folder because you chose Add Bookmark from the Share options. But the Bookmark folder is also a button. If you double tap it, you will open a folder list that includes the Favorites folder and an option to create a new folder.

11. Choose the **Favorites** folder or leave **Bookmarks** as is.

Tip: Functionally, there is no difference between Bookmarks and Favorites. The choice is personal preference.

12. Touch the **Save** button in the upper right corner. Then double tap to save your bookmark.

Finding a Bookmark

13. Touch the **Bookmark** button at the bottom of your device screen, to the right of the **Share** button.
14. Double tap to open **Bookmarks**. The **Favorites** folder is in the **Bookmarks** list.
15. If you saved your website in the **Bookmarks** folder, it appears in the **Bookmarks** list.

16. If you saved your website in the **Favorites** folder, right swipe to the **Favorites** folder and then double tap.
17. To open your saved website, right swipe to it and double tap to open it.
