Making a Phone Call

A handy Amazon Echo feature is the ability to have Alexa make a phone call. Just say your wake word, and then say the phone number. For example: “Alexa, call 800-323-4238.” Alexa dials the number, and you listen and talk using the Amazon Echo like a speaker phone.

Getting Started

1. Open the Amazon Alexa app on your smartphone, tablet, or on the web at **alexa.amazon.com**.
2. Select **Settings**.
3. Select **Device Settings**.
4. Choose your device from the list.
5. Select **Communications**.
6. Switch the **Communications** toggle to “Enabled for this device.”

Now you can call phone numbers or ask Alexa to call people in your contacts list.

Note: Enabling **Communications** lets you turn on the **Announcements** and **Drop-In** features. These features let you communicate between Amazon Echo devices in your household. To activate these features, select the menu options within the app.
