Smart Home

You can make your home “smarter” by connecting other smart appliances, like lights, thermostats, and TVs, to your Amazon Echo. Then you can use your voice to turn on lights, set the room temperature, or switch channels on the TV.

First, check the information that came with the appliance. Make sure the appliance works with Alexa, and find out if you need to put it in “pairing mode.”

Here are two ways to get started:

Use Voice Prompts

1. Turn on the device you want to connect.
2. Say, “Alexa, look for my new devices.”
3. Respond to the prompts to connect your device.

Use the App

1. Turn on the device you want to connect.
2. Open the Amazon Alexa app on your smartphone, tablet, or on the web at **alexa.amazon.com**.
3. Select **Devices**.
4. Tap the **+** symbol in the upper right corner.
5. Select Add Device.
6. Choose one of the devices shown.
7. Follow on-screen prompts to connect the device.

After you've connected your new device to Alexa, use voice commands to operate the device. For example: "Alexa, set the oven to 350 degrees."

Congratulations! You've just made your home a little bit smarter.
