Keeping Apps Up-to-Date on Your Android Phone

Android sometimes updates the apps on your phone. New features may be added, or an update may fix an app that wasn't working as intended.

It's a good idea to keep your apps up-to-date, so you always have the latest features and bug fixes installed. Here's how to do it.

1. Open the **Play Store** app.
2. In the top right corner of the screen, find the button that shows the name of your **Google account**. For example: "signed in as techhadley@gmail.com."
3. Double tap the button to show information about your account.
4. Swipe through the options until you locate **Manage apps and device**. Double tap to open.
5. Use one finger to right swipe through the options. You'll first find information about **Play Protect Scan**, which keeps you safe from harmful apps.
6. Next, you'll find info on the number of updates available for your phone.

7. Right swipe once more to find the **Update All** button, and double tap to activate it. Your phone will begin downloading and installing the updates.
8. If you'd rather see which updates are available and choose to update each app individually, right swipe past the **Update All** button to find the **See Details** button.
9. Double-tap this button to display each app that has an update.
10. Choose the **Update** button for each app you want to update. Any app you don't update remains at its current version.
