



iPhone/iPad VoiceOver On and Off

You can easily turn VoiceOver on and off!

VoiceOver is Apple's screen reading software. A screen reader gives those with visual impairment the ability to use their devices to the fullest by speaking the items or information on the screen. And Apple makes it simple to turn VoiceOver on and off. **Try it out!**

Tip: The following instructions are for the iPhone. However, they are very similar whether you're using an iPhone or an iPad.

Tip: Apple calls Siri a personal assistant. Siri helps you do things like set reminders or calendar events, perform web searches, place a phone call, or send a text message on your Apple device.

Turn VoiceOver On Using Siri

1. Say, "Hey, Siri" to start Siri.
2. Then say, "Turn on VoiceOver." Siri announces that VoiceOver is now on.

Turn VoiceOver Off Using Siri

3. Say, “Hey, Siri” to start Siri.
4. Then say, “Turn VoiceOver off.” This time, VoiceOver announces that VoiceOver is off.
