Setting Up Your Phone to Use the Navigation Bar with Android

The Android navigation bar is a group of three buttons across the bottom of the screen. These buttons let you quickly navigate to the previous screen, the home screen, and a list of currently open apps without using gestures.

Here's how to set up your phone to display the navigation bar.

1. Open the **Settings** app.
2. Select **System**.
3. Select **Gestures** under **System Settings**.
4. Select **System Navigation**.
5. Select **Three-Button Navigation**.

Your phone will now display three buttons at the bottom of every screen. These buttons are labeled **Back**, **Home**, and **Overview**.
