Siri for Do Not Disturb

You can easily turn on Do Not Disturb using Siri.

Siri helps you do things on your Apple devices, including silencing your phone calls and notifications if you're in a meeting, movie theater, or library where you don't want to be disturbed. **Give it a try!**

Tip: Siri is usually turned on during the setup process for your device. But if you haven't yet set up Siri, contact a Hadley learning expert for help.

Tip: To get the most interaction from Siri, make sure VoiceOver (Apple's built-in screen reading software) is running on your device. If you're not familiar with VoiceOver, check out the Listen with VoiceOver series.

Using Siri to Turn On Do Not Disturb

1. Say, "Hey Siri" or "Siri." Then say, "Turn on Do Not Disturb."
2. Siri says, "OK, I turned Do Not Disturb on."
3. Swipe up to close Siri.

Using Siri to Turn Off Do Not Disturb

4. Say, “Hey Siri” or “Siri.” Then say, “Turn off Do Not Disturb.”
5. Siri says, “OK, Do Not Disturb is now off.”
6. Swipe up to close Siri.

Now you have an easy way to silence your phone calls or notifications using Do Not Disturb. Give another workshop a try to see how you can use Siri to set timers.
