Smart and Classic Invert by App

Inverting colors turns your screen's bright, light-colored background with dark text to a dark-colored background with light text. This can be more comfortable on the eyes by reducing glare and eye fatigue. Try it out!

Smart and Classic Invert Features

Smart Invert reverses the color on the screen except for images, videos, and some apps that use dark color styles.

Classic Invert reverses all the colors on the screen, including images, videos, and apps.

Turning the Invert Color Features On and Off

Version iOS 13 or Later

1. Open the **Settings** app.
2. Scroll down to **Accessibility**.

3. Tap on **Display & Text Size**.
4. Scroll down to find **Smart Invert** and **Classic Invert**.
5. Tap the toggle button next to the desired **Invert** type to turn it on or off.

Version iOS 12 or Older

6. Open the **Settings** app.
7. Scroll down to **General**.
8. Tap on **Accessibility**.
9. Tap **Display Accommodations** and then tap **Invert Colors**.
10. Tap the toggle button next to the desired **Invert** type to turn it on or off.
