Setting Up Siri

Siri is the Mac's digital assistant that responds to voice commands and questions.

Tip: For Siri to work, the Mac must first be connected to the Internet.

Turn Siri On or Make Changes to Siri Settings

1. Open the **Apple** menu and select **System Settings**.

Tip: On an older Mac, the menu option is called **System Preferences**.

2. Choose **Siri** from the **Settings** menu.
3. Then select **Listen for "Hey Siri."**

Tip: Other available settings include options for Siri's voice, the keyboard shortcut for Siri, and more.

Using Voice Commands for Siri

4. Say, "Hey Siri, What time is it?"
5. Siri responds with the current time.
6. Try other questions, like "Hey Siri, what is tomorrow's weather?"

Using the Keyboard Shortcut for Siri

7. Press and hold **Command key + Spacebar** until Siri responds.
8. Speak a command or question, like, “What’s tomorrow’s weather?” or “What time is it?”
9. Siri responds with the answer.
