Adjusting the Voice for Spoken Content

Fine-tune the voice settings in **Spoken Content**.

Changing the Voice

1. Open the **Apple** menu and select **System Settings**.
2. Select **Accessibility** from the left panel.
3. Next, select **Spoken Content** on the right.
4. The default setting is **Use System Language**.
Choose a different language, if necessary.
5. Select the drop-down menu next to **System Voice** and choose a voice.

Tip: To add more voices, select **Manage Voices** from the drop-down menu and choose a voice to download.

Adjusting the Speaking Rate and Volume

6. Use the mouse or trackpad to move the **Speaking Rate** slider to the left (slower) or right (faster).
7. Use the mouse or trackpad to move the **Volume** slider left (less volume) or right (more volume).

Tip: Changing the volume in Spoken Content does not change the overall system volume, just the volume for Spoken Content.

Tip: Test the changes you made by selecting the Play Sample button below the sliders.
