



Seeing AI: Android Low Vision Identifying Money

Use Seeing AI to help you identify money!

Seeing AI uses your device's camera to scan money and read its denomination. **Try it out!**

Tip: If you don't yet have the Seeing AI app, you can get it by going to the Google Play store on your device and typing "Seeing AI" in the search field. Or contact a Hadley learning specialist for help.

Scanning Money

1. Open the **Seeing AI** app.

Tip: The first time you open the app, a short tutorial pops up. The tutorial offers some helpful info, so it's a good idea to check it out before moving on to using the app.

2. Find money of any denomination, for example a one, five, or ten dollar bill, and place it on a flat surface.

3. Tap the **Currency** channel at the bottom of the screen. The icon looks like a dollar bill.
4. Your camera app opens. Hold your phone above the bill.
5. Seeing AI tells you the denomination of your bill.

Tip: Your bill doesn't have to be on a flat surface for Seeing AI to identify it. When you're at the check-out in the grocery store, hold the bill out in front of you (it doesn't matter which side of the bill is facing you) and Seeing AI will quickly identify it for you.
